Bridgeport Launches and Trail Head Grand Opening

Bill Wheeler reported that the Davis Park launch is operational while the Hoffmann Community Park launch remains closed. Some installation issues need to be resolved before the floating dock is installed and the park opened. A Grand Opening event will be held in June or July to highlight the new Davis Park Launch, the Hoffmann Community Park Launch and the Trailhead site modifications.

Log Jam

A large log jam has been reported to be downstream of Bridgeport between Davis Park and the M-13 Boat Launch (near the Bridgeport Waste Water Treatmant Plant). Portage around the log jam is not a viable option. Bill Wheeler has begun to investigate. To date, the cost estiimates to remove and dispose of the logs run \$20,000 or more. A MDEQ permit has been issued for removal.

We are looking at alternatives and funding. Ideas/suggestions welcome.

319 Implementation Grant – Livestock/Manure Management

Mike Boike reported that the project timeline has been extended to later this year. Twenty high value sites have been identified for consideration. To date, owner receptivity to this project has been low. Mike and the team will continue contacting owners and promoting the project.

Caine Road Kiosk

Russ Fall reported he is ready to issue a purchase order for the kiosk stand (thanks to support from Vassar Township and Saginaw Bay WIN). When UM Flint completes design work, the remaining panels and the kiosk stand will be ordered.

New WaterTrail Brochure

Jeanna Rogner, Premier Promotions Graphic Design/Marketing, has begun design work on a new, updated Cass River WaterTrail Brochure. This was made possible with grants from The Scollon Family Foundation and Saginaw Bay WIN. We hope to have new brochures available in a month or so.
